

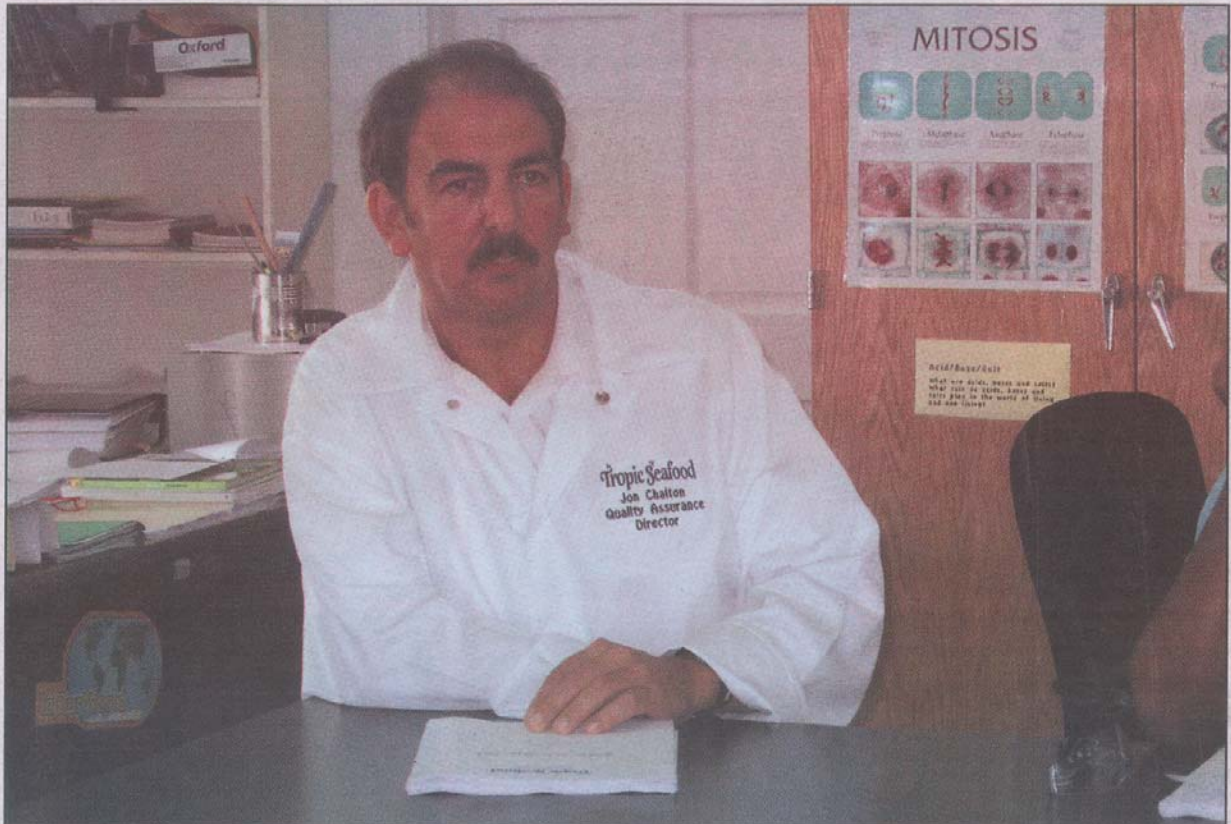
BFS helps students with Biology project!
